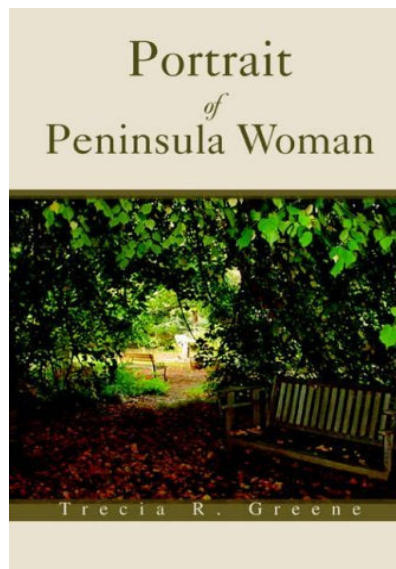


**Portrait of Peninsula Woman by Trecia R. Greene**
